Dear Major Advisor:

The Academic Advising Center values your assistance to students who are on probation. As part of the student's hold, they are required to meet with their major advisor to:

1) Set up a realistic academic plan

- -Some students shouldn't be encouraged to take full-time school.
- -Please ask how much time they have to devote to school each week.
- -Too many classes deemed difficult or time-consuming could be considered unrealistic

2) Learn about the major and how to successfully declare a major

- -Curriculum overview
- -Special admission requirements
- -Process to apply to program or declare
- -Pre-requisites information

3) Discuss how to be successful within major coursework

- -When courses are offered
- -What courses go well together and which courses should be separated
- -Strategies for repeating major classes
- -Specific major, department, or college resources available
